Congratulations to **Charles McDermott** who has successfully been awarded with RSci Status! Well done Charles, we know how much hard work and effort goes into these applications.


Whilst we are overjoyed that we are receiving a large number of applications; such a positive response to the accreditation standards we do apologise as we have had to increase our turnaround times as follows:
