Association of Simulated Practice in Healthcare expression of interest form

This is a call for an expression of interest in being a voluntary Executive Committee member on the Association of Simulated Practice in Healthcare (ASPiH) Executive Committee.

The ASPiH Executive Committee (EC) comprises of strong representation from interprofessional colleagues working in a variety of simulation and interactive learning facilities across the National Health Service and the educational sector. Our present intention is to strengthen the medical representation within the ASPiH Executive Committee.

Applicants will be appointed from the current ASPiH membership.

The three vacant roles that ASPiH wish to fill are:

1. Journal Liaison Lead
2. Standards and Accreditation committee member
3. Patient Engagement Lead

These roles are to support our operational strategy, and build upon existing relationships, concepts and processes.

All EC members are encouraged to support Special Interest Groups (SIG) activity related to their interests and conference activity, so joining the EC provides a broad and varied opportunity to work at a national level.

Each role will be supported by the current ASPiH directors, Colette Laws-Chapman (President), Mike Morrow (Treasurer), Sharon Weldon (President-elect) and Kevin Stirling (Secretary).

Length of Term on the ASPiH EC:

- 4 years maximum unless you apply and are successfully appointed to an ASPiH Director position.

Successful applicants will support the Executive Committee to deliver ASPiH membership activities, therefore please ensure you tell us about the qualities and the values that you believe you will bring to the specific role you are applying for as well as the wider management structure.

Please provide an expression of interest letter (maximum 500 words) outlining:

- 1) Full Name and credentials
- 2) Current Job Title(s)
- 3) ASPiH membership number
- 4) Your interest in joining the ASPiH executive committee, with specific reference to the role that you're interested in supporting and developing.
- 5) Your track record as an effective, dynamic leader who will be able to reinforce the stated mission of the Association and the ASPiH 2023 Standards.
- 6) Your commitment to the mission and standards of the Association

- 7) Your experience of working on committees and/ or projects in the public, private or third sector

What can the ASPiH executive experience bring to you?

ASPiH continues to expand its areas of operation and grow in membership. Our Annual Conference is developing in both size and quality, while the projects being undertaken and our relationships with affiliate organisations and commercial partners are developing in their depth and complexity. We also support Executive Committee members to attend one other annual face-to-face Executive Committee meeting. These face-to-face opportunities allow us to collaborate and create effective networking relationships with likeminded individuals.

The successful applicant will have the opportunity to develop their own areas of expertise through any of the Special Interest Groups and of course on future projects that fall within the strategic vision of ASPiH.
